

Message from Chris Philp MP

The planning committee's Labour councillors are still pressing ahead with further damaging plans for the area. **Please demonstrate again at 6:15pm next Thursday, 30th May, just before the council's planning meeting.** The meeting will start inside at 6:30pm and there will be a public gallery. There will be four applications that will be especially out of keeping for their locations:

59 Rectory Park – 18/05383/FUL – Sanderstead Ward

Demolition of a single detached family home, to be replaced with a block of 6 flats

43 Kingswood Lane – 19/01561/FUL – Sanderstead Ward

Demolition of a single detached family home and development of 9 flats - this is a tranquil location next to the ancient woodland of Kings Wood

11 Barham road – 19/00167/FUL – Waddon Ward

Conversion of a Victorian built, semi-detached home from family housing to 5 flats

42 Grovelands Road – 19/00886/FUL – Purley & Woodcote Ward

Demolition of single detached family home and development of 9 flats

If the applications go through, each will be another family home lost to over development, and will have an impact on the wider neighbourhood. This is about protecting the character of our area

It's incredibly important that we stop the council from continuing with its disastrous policies. Protesting, and showing the strength of opposition to these applications is the best way to make the council listen.
